
About Partners in Art


Partners in Art is a volunteer organization focused on education and philanthropy. Membership is limited to about 70, on a first come, first served basis. All members are required to pay social dues of \$300 per year and in addition are required to donate at least \$350 to the group's charitable efforts. The group holds fundraising events, attracts sponsors to fund its activities and accepts donations from the public. Proposals for funding are welcomed and reviewed by a project development committee. Generally PIA prefers an active collaboration on a project. PIA has supported both large (over \$100 000) and small (\$10 000 - \$15 000) projects, and is interested in focusing on education, publication, and promoting alliances between global thinkers in the visual arts.

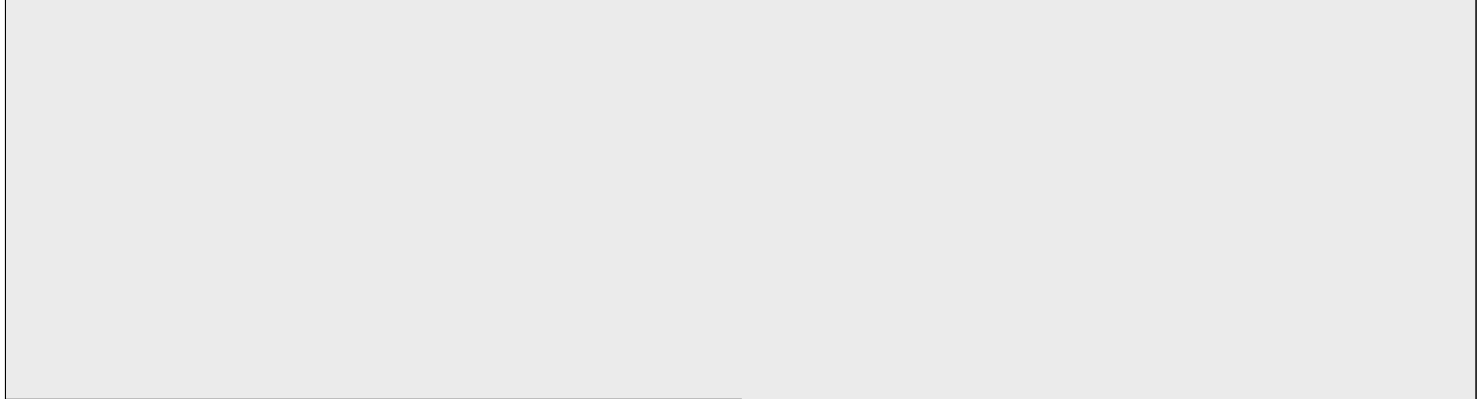

History of Partners in Art

Partners in Art (PIA) was established in 2002; incorporated in Canada as a not-for-profit corporation in 2004 and achieved charitable status in 2006. The group devotes money and volunteer time to raise the profile of art and artists within the community. PIA generally formulates partnering plans on a yearly and project-by-project basis. The group has approximately 70 members and operates in the City of Toronto. In the past PIA has collaborated with the The Power Plant, The Art Gallery of Ontario, The Museum of Contemporary Canadian Art, Canadian Art Foundation, The Ontario College of Art and Design, The Institute for Contemporary Culture at the ROM and the Galerie de l'Université du Québec à Montréal.

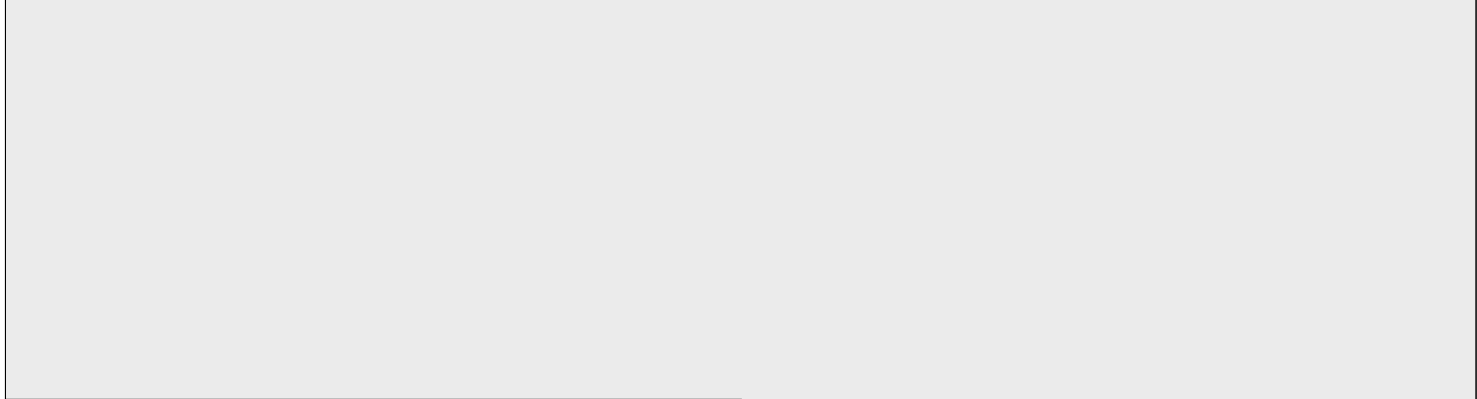

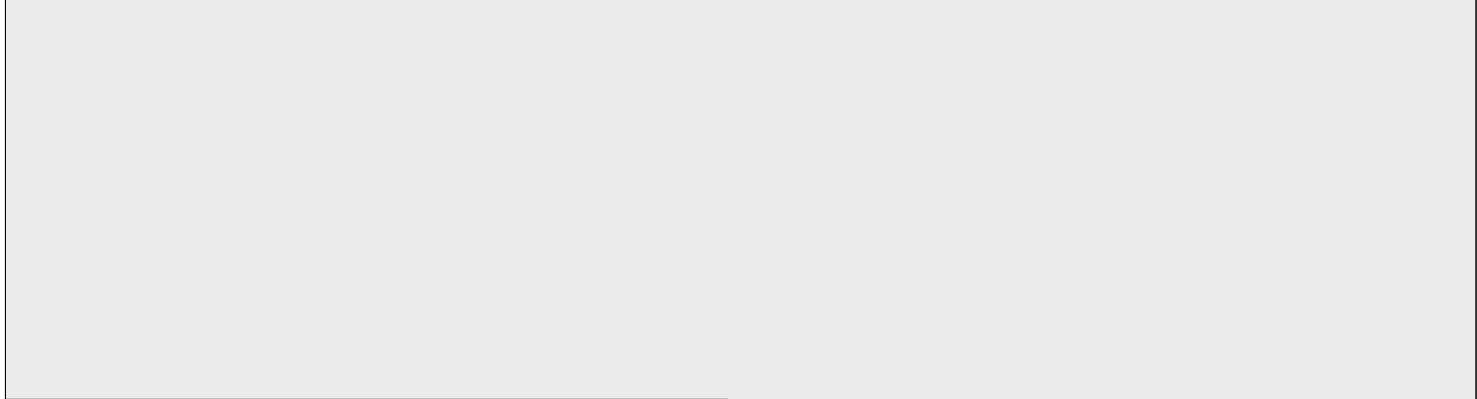

The focus of the education is contemporary visual art and culture. Every other year PIA runs a panel discussion on subjects that will help refine its strategic direction.

In addition to PIA members, the invited audience includes: leaders in Toronto's art community and businesses, curators, artists, art students, media, government and PIA sponsors. Previous topics have explored the essence of successful cultural collaborations and how to foster a dynamic arts community.

1 Project grid. Each project will have an associated "feature image".

2 Project details to include:

- Project type and project status
- Partner name
- Project name

3 Project navigation. The project listing grid would be sortable by:

- Date
- Project status (current + upcoming)
- Project type (project + events)
- Partner

The general navigation style was designed with Mercer Union in mind.

The menu would slide down the page as user scrolls down - it would always be visible.




4 Variable project sizes can really make a grid more visually interesting and easier to scan. It is recommended that some projects be designated in a way that will effect the listing box size. This designation could be


- Featured project / minor project
- Project type

4 Infinite scrolling. In order to keep the listing from feeling too technical and in order to make it effortless to use, all projects would be loaded onto one page - there would be no pagination.




5 Lazy loading. In order to keep page load times light, new projects would be loaded as user scrolls down page (see google images for example).
